# St Agnes: A diamond in Cornwall's mining crown

St Agnes Mining District

Our mining culture shaped your world





Time required Allow 31/2 hours

As you walk around St Agnes, you'll find remains of its mining history all around you. Some you can't miss, like the chimney stacks and engine houses. Less obvious are the tunnels and adits etched in the cliffs, the waste humps and hollows amidst the gorse, orthe bare spoil heaps.

#### **By train**

- 7 miles from Redruth station.
- 8 miles from Truro station.



#### By car

- From the A30, take the B3277 signposted to St Agnes. After crossing the second roundabout take the third left into Trelawny Road.
- There is a pay and display car park on Trelawny Road at the start of the trail.



# By bus

- From Truro No. 85.
- From Redruth No. 315.

#### About the trail



Approximate walking time: Allow 31/2 hours.

**Grade of Walk:** Strenuous. The terrain consists of unmade tracks and coastal footpaths with some small sections of paved roads. Steep climbs and steps can also be found on the route



Accessibility: Not suitable for wheelchair users.



**Toilets:** Public toilet facilities are available at Trevaunance Cove.



**Health & Safety:** Please take care as the trail involves some steep hills and sea cliffs. Also be aware of traffic when walking alongsid roads.

**Facilities:** There are a number of establishments serving refreshments in St Agnes, plus Driftwood Spars at Trevaunance Cove.
